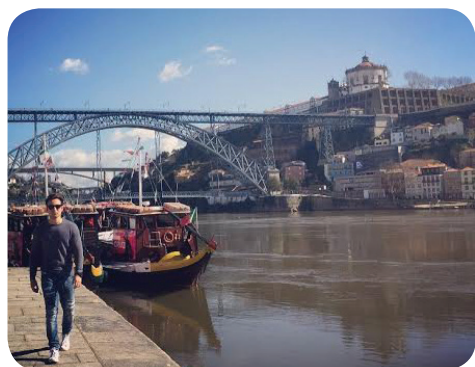
STUDENT AND STAFF MOBILITY WITHIN ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME



Erasmus+

ISSBS is carrying out two mobility projects within the Erasmus+ programme. In the first half of 2016, three ISSBS' students studied at the partner university in Portugal and during the summer one of the students will carry out an internship in Austria. Within both projects, five members of ISSBS staff have already participated in a mobility for teaching





or training (Thailand, Poland, Romania), and in May ISSBS has hosted a lecturer from Al Akhawayn University, Morocco. The next Erasmus+ students' call for participants (for the academic year 2017/2018) will be released in January 2017.

PROJECT AND INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE »INCLUSIVE HRM PRACTICES FOR OLDER WORKERS«



On 6th April 2016, ISSBS organized a one-day international conference on "Inclusive Human Resources Management Practices for Older Workers". The conference was a part of the dissemination activities of the eponymous project conducted by ISSBS and its international partners (<http://i-hrm.eu>).



Especially interesting were the guest lectures by Dr. Dirk van Dierendonck from Erasmus University Rotterdam (The Netherlands) "State of the art: Elderly and work - what do researches show?", Mrs. Ana Barroca from Advancis (Portugal) "Elderly and work - Best Practices of Inclusion", Mrs. Dalje Jogan from Istrabenz plini (Slovenia) "Inclusion of elderly and work environment through the lens of HR

manager", and a lecture by Mr. Yvor Broer from inDialogue (Denmark) "Intergenerational dialogue and practice".

6TH KOMÉ STUDENT CONFERENCE



7 April 2016 / Student council and ISSBS have organized 6th KoMe ((Konferenca MEDnarodnih - eng. Conference of the International) student conference entitled "Responsibility in Doing Business". The key topic of the conference has been a lesson learned by many companies, that it is easier to achieve good results in synergy and that it is important to return some of the profits back to the local community that supports them. Conference participants discussed the best social responsibility practices of companies' in respect to their shareholders, employees and especially to ethical standards. Other important topics of the conference were also entrepreneurship, new business practices, business ethics, human resources development and employment, and the effectiveness and efficiency of enterprises.

INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP "TOOLS FOR DATA MANAGEMENT - SUPPORTING THE DATA DRIVEN DECISION MAKING FOR INTERNATIONALIZATION OF HIGHER EDUCATION"

On 14th April 2016, ISSBS and its project partners organized a one-day international workshop "Tools for Data Management - Supporting the Data Driven Decision Making for Internationalization of Higher Education". The workshop was intended for employees in higher education sector that are involved in the internationalization activities of their institutions, for example, associate deans for international cooperation, university teachers, members of the international



office and department of informatics, staff responsible for quality assurance etc. Participants contributed to the Beta version of the IT tool for information sharing and training module.

PROJECT DANUBE REGION STRATEGY AND "INTEGRATION OF ROMA CHILDREN IN THE EDUCATION SYSTEM"



The main objective of this project »Integration of Roma children into education system - countries of Danube region« is to equip teachers

and Roma school mediators/assistants with the necessary skills and knowledge for working with Roma children as well as to exchange good practices among teachers from Slovenia, Romania and Serbia.

In March, April and May trainings for teachers and Roma mediators/assistants were organized in Slovenia, Serbia and Romania, which were attended by a total of more than 100 participants. On 27th May 2016, the conference "The role of the integration of Roma children into education system" was carried out in Timisoara, Romania, which was attended by more than 110 participants. The conference participants were members of different interested groups, e.g. representatives of the Ministries of Education, members of the Roma community, academics, teachers, Roma mediators/Roma assistants etc.
