students, who graduated in the academic year 2015/2016, recived their diplomas. There were 26 graduates of the programme Economics in Contemporary Society, 49 graduates of the programme Business in Contemporary Society and 46 graduates of the masters' programme Knowledge Management. 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MOBILITY PROJECTS AND STUDENTS ABOUT THEIR MOBILITY EXPERIENCE





In 2016/2017, ISSBS is carrying out three Erasmus+ mobility projects. In the context of these projects, the faculty will enable four students to take part in an international mobility for study or traineeship. Also, fifteen outbound staff teaching or training mobilities abroad are planned, including mobilities at partner institutions in countries such as Thailand, Morocco, Hong Kong, Moldova, Israel and Kosovo. Mobility projects also include twelve inbound mobilities of foreign higher education teachers, which will increase the scope of interdisciplinary education at ISSBS, international experience of non-mobile students, lectures in a foreign language, and access to course content from other cultural contexts and enable a comparison with the domestic business and academic environment.

FIRST IMPLEMENTATION OF PHD PROGRAMME IN ENGLISH



With the beginning of the academic year 2016/2017, ISSBS started with the first implementation of the doctoral study programme Knowledge management in English. Besides Slovenian doctoral students, four foreign students are also enrolled in the programme. Beginning of the doctoral programme in English is a turning point for the faculty at its 10th anniversary and an important



step towards achieving its long term vision. It aspires to be recognised for its academic quality and social responsibility. All faculty's activities are directed to developing and implementing high-quality and internationally oriented study to increase the employability of (post)graduate students and to enhance their professional development. Implementation of study programmes in English contirbute to higher internationalization of education at home, which will further improve the quality of teaching and learning for all students and improve the quality of the international dimension of the Slovenian higher education as a whole.
